Descendants of Seth Wheelock (about 1752 - 1806)

Generation Number 1

1. **Seth Wheelock** was born about 1752, in Charlton, Worcester Co, MA,¹ died in Feb 1806, in Charlton, Worcester Co, MA.^{2,3} He married (1) Elizabeth Thayer on 8 Apr 1784, in Charlton, Worcester, MA.^{4,5} Elizabeth Thayer was born on 6 Dec 1749, in Mendon, Worcester Co, MA,⁶ died before 16 Sep 1803.⁷ He married (2) Lucy Johnson on 9 Apr 1805, in Charlton, Worcester, MA.⁸ Lucy Johnson died on 11 Sep 1824, in Charlton, Worcester Co, MA.^{9,10}

Notes for Seth Wheelock: Seth Wheelock was a private in the Revolutionary War, serving in Captain Jacob Davis' Company (Colonel Ebenezer Learned's Regiment) which marched on the Lexington Alarm of 19 Apr 1775. He later served as a Corporal in Captain Abijah Lamb's Company, Colonel Jonathan Holman's Regiment. He then served in various capacities in Fishkill, NY, and Providence, RI. In 1778 he is listed as 26 years of age, 5 ft 10 inches tall.

His death is recorded in the diary of his niece, Polly (Converse) Wheelock, who noted on the 7th of February 1806 that "Uncle Seth Wheelock died in a fit."

Notes for Elizabeth Thayer: She is referred to as the "widow Elizabeth Weld" in her 1784 Charlton

marriage intention to Seth Wheelock. The 1775 administration of estate of Stephen Weld (Worcester County probate case 62851) identifies the metes and bounds of a dower parcel for his widow, Elizabeth Weld. Tracing the dower parcel through subsequent owners reveals that Elizabeth and Seth lived on the parcel, probably until their deaths in 1803 and 1806 respectively. In particular, see 1806 Worcester County deeds 162:612, Molly Weld to Josiah Weld, 162:613 Josiah Weld to Eli Curtis, and 162:616 Eli Curtis to John Wheelock. Also, see 1805 Worcester County deed 158:592 Seth Jones to Aaron Wheelock.

2. **Welcome Wheelock (Seth)** was born on 26 Sep 1784, in Charlton, Worcester, MA,¹ died on 20 Mar 1865, in Calais, Washington, VT,² buried in Robinson Cemetery, Calais, VT.³ He married Clare Wheelock on 13 Feb 1813.⁴ Clare Wheelock was born on 20 Apr 1785, in Charlton, Worcester, MA,⁵ died on 22 Aug 1850, in Calais, Washington, VT,⁶ buried in Robinson Cemetery, Calais, VT.⁷

Notes for Welcome Wheelock: The headstone identifies Welcome as a Captain, GAR POST 29.

According to "The Wheelock Family of Calais, VT", by Marcus W. Waite:

He came to Calais as early as 1808, and on Nov 6, 1812 bought of Abijah Wheelock 86 acres of land in lot 51 of the 1st division, where they made their home for many years. Clara died Aug 22, 1850 and Welcom died Mar. 20, 1865. He was selectman 1825-26 and 1837, and held other town offices. He was owner of three pews in the "Old West Church", Calais. Both he and Clara are buried in Robinson Cemetery, in Calais. A newspaper notice at time of his death states: "At the time of his death he was clerk and treasurer of the first Universalist Society in Clais, which office he had held for the last 25 years and had never been absent from a meeting. He was also clerk of the first Meeting-house Society in Calais for the last 31 years, and had also been clerk and treasurer of the school district in which he lived for the last 30 years." His granddaughter, (Miss Carrie Wheelock) has three commissions signed by the Governor of Vermont, appointing him 2nd Lieutenant, then 1st Lieutenant, and finally Captain.

iii. **Clarissa Wheelock** was born on 24 Mar 1820, in Calais, VT,^{1,2} died on 19 Oct 1902, in Littleton, Middlesex Co, MA,³ buried in Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton, Middlesex Co, MA.⁴ She married Gardner Prouty on 3 Jun 1851, in Boston, MA.⁵ Gardner Prouty was born on 4 Sep 1817,⁶ died on 5 Dec 1899,⁷ buried in Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton, Middlesex Co, MA.⁸

Clarissa Wheelock's Littleton death record gives an age at death of 82y 7m 25d which would imply a birth date of 24 Feb 1820. Given that this disagrees with her headstone, and with the date reported by "The Wheelock Family of Calais", it is assumed that the death record is in error.

3. **Wate Wheelock (Seth)** was born on 16 Apr 1786, in Charlton, Worcester Co, MA,^{1,2} died on 10 Mar 1861, in Charlton, Worcester Co, MA,^{3,4} buried in Northside Cemetery, Charlton, MA.⁵ He married Lucinda Lamb on 18 Dec 1817, in Spencer, Worcester, MA.⁶ Lucinda Lamb was born on 27 Jul 1792, in Spencer, Worcester Co, MA,⁷ died on 1 Nov 1880, in Charlton, Worcester Co, MA,^{8,9} buried in Northside Cemetery, Charlton, MA.¹⁰

Notes for Lucinda Lamb: She was the daughter of David and Jemima Lamb, both of Spencer (per death record).

Notes for Wainy Wheelock: Wainy's headstone, located in the North St. Cemetery, in the center of Spencer, MA, states that she died 30 Mar 1852, at the age of 59 years. She is buried next to her husband, Jonas.

profession of teaching kindergarten, which she apparently pursued most of her adult life.

The papers of the Langdon C. Wheelock family, archived in the Aldrich Public Library in Barre, Vt. contain a "Composition Book" maintained by Carrie. Inside this book is a business card which reads: "The Kindergarten will open in Mrs. Wheelocks Main St. home, Monday, Aug 30, 1886, terms \$4/month, hours 9 to 12 AM."

The composition book has several hundred entries, one for each of her kindergarten students. Each entry indicates date of birth, date of entry into the kindergarten, and newspaper clippings indicating important events in the life of that person, including in some cases, the obituary.

Carrie obviously maintained this album over many years of her life, and took great pride in the accomplishments of her students.

There is no indication that she ever married.
